Apple Oatmeal Muffins



Ingredients

- 1/2 cup milk, non-fat
- 1/3 cup applesauce, unsweetened
- 1/2 cup quick-cooking oats, uncooked
- 1 cup sugar
- 1/2 tablespoon baking powder
- 1/2 teaspoon ground cinnamon
- 1 tart apple, cored & chopped

- 1. Wash hands with soap and water.
- 2. Preheat oven to 400 °F.
- 3. Place 6 cupcake holders in baking
- 4. In a mixing bowl, add milk and applesauce. Stir until blended.
- 1/2 cup all-purpose flour 5. Stir in flour, oats, sugar, baking powder, and cinnamon. Mix until moistened (do not over mix).
 - 6. Gently stir in the chopped apples.
 - 7. Spoon into cupcake holders.
 - 8. Bake for 15-20 minutes or until an inserted toothpick comes out clean.
 - 9. Cool in pan 5 minutes before serving. Store unused portions in an airtight container.
